A hidden adventurer's paradise, Eastern Oregon offers unparalleled opportunities for off-grid exploration and relaxation. We add professional, deeply caring guides and modern camp amenities for something we describe as **luxury for the soul**.

- **Remote & Wild:** We guide in the southern Wallowa Mountains (which hold the Eagle Cap Wilderness) and the Elkhorn Range of the Blue Mountains, some of the most remote land in Oregon. Come for the views not the crowds.
- **Alpine Forests, Glacial Waters:** Hike through wild coniferous forests to lakes and valleys carved by the glaciers of the last ice age. Rivers and lakes make for amazing multi-sport trips: trekking, paddling, fishing.
- **Big Starry Skies:** With little to no light pollution, Eastern Oregon boasts some of the darkest skies in the world! See 2-4 thousand stars with the naked eye.
- **Indigenous History:** Native Americans have lived on these lands since time immemorial. Learn about Indigenous history and practices of interacting with the land and become inspired to be a better steward of the wild.

# TRIP ITINERARY

DAY	FOCUS	MAIN ACTIVITIES
0	Arrival- Day Before Trip Start	Meet at Dan’s house in La Grande for a true Eastern Oregon welcome. Share a beer and appetizer, double check gear, and get to know your guides. Retire to your hotel for dinner and rest.
1	Into the Wilderness	Enjoy complimentary pick up in Sully, our adventure van. After a ~1 hour drive to the trailhead, meet our expert mule packer who packs in your personal gear, 30lbs / person. Step into the wilderness and leave the hustle of the city behind.
Middle Days	Day Hikes / Wilderness Activities	At camp, your professional local guides turn into expert fun facilitators and chefs, serving hand crafted appetizers, cocktails, and gourmet campfire cooked meals, all sourced from hyper local ingredients. During the day, explore nearby lakes on guided hikes, try your hand at fly fishing, hatchet throwing, forage for wild edible plants, or relax at camp. <i>Hikes range from 4-7 miles RT.</i>
Final Day	Back to Civilization	<p>After your last delicious camp breakfast, pack up your gear to leave at camp for our mule packer to carry out for you. While it's tempting to put your head down and hustle (like a horse to the barn), your last day is a chance to deepen your experience in the wild and enjoy the stroll back to civilization.</p> <p><i>Typically, groups reach the trailhead between 1-4PM, please plan flights &amp; travel plans accordingly.</i></p>



# WHAT'S AT CAMP

*Camping. Elevated.*

- **Gourmet, farm-to-table meals.**
  - Meals are cooked on an open fire (seasonally dependent)
  - We try our best to accommodate all dietary restrictions
  - Meals begin with coffee service--> breakfast, lunch, appetizers, dinner, dessert, cocktails.
- **Craft cocktails** or **mocktails** using seasonal and local ingredients
- **State of the Art Equipment:**
  - **Tents**- depending on group size you will stay in a deluxe canvas tent (1-4 people) or smaller dome tents for larger groups (2 people to a 4 person tent).
  - **Cots**- sleep on CampTime fabric cots with integrated sleeping pads
  - **Sleeping bags**- bring your own or use one of our Big Agnes mummy bags
  - **Camp lighting**- solar string and overhead lights
  - **Chairs** for meal times and hang times
  - **Camp Bathroom**- no squatting on luxury trips. Camp is complete with a sit-down pit toilet system
  - **Group kitchen gear**- cooking equipment, plates, bowls, cutlery, drink ware, etc.
  - **Activity gear**- from hanging in a hammock to axe throwing to playing cards
  - **Fly Fishing Equipment**- complete rod set ups with area specific flies
  - **Inflatable Kayak(s)**- for fishing, lake races, playing on the water

- **Traditional Archery Shooting** (+\$100/person)
- **En Plein Air**- Natural Wilderness Painting Session with local artist (+\$900)
- **Mountain Masseuse** (+\$250/person) (Min 3 pp)

The backcountry is a wild place – literally. There's no running water, no landing strips, no vehicle access. We pack in all of our camps on mules that carry ~120lbs of gear per animal. Our camps highlight the wilderness that surrounds them. We use state-of-the-art materials to create a space that is as authentic as it is luxurious:





# INCLUSIONS & CAMP NOTES

## Inclusions:

- Local, professional, naturalist guides
- Mule packer to carry 30lbs of personal gear per person
- All meals, beverages & cocktail package
- All camp / hike gear- tents, cots, pads, chairs, group gear, kitchen, etc.
- Camp games, activities- we are professional wilderness fun facilitators- including fly fishing, kayaking, hatchet throwing, and more
- Transportation from La Grande, OR to the trailhead and back
- Professional photographer & download link to photos
- Meet & greet the evening before your adventure with hosted beverages

**Not Included:** flights, hotels



**Bathroom:** for our luxury basecamps, we construct a vaulted toilet with a sit-down frame and privacy shelter away from camp. No running water, so scoops of dirt and lime help compost and reduce odor.

**Showers:** most of our guests prefer dips in crystal clear meadow creeks and alpine lakes for their "backcountry shower;" however, hanging solar showers are available upon request.

**Cell Reception:** we firmly believe that to re-connect we need to disconnect. At the majority of our camps there is no cell service. However, we understand that occasionally circumstances exist where communication with "the outside" is necessary. Please contact us with concerns.

**Safety:** Our guides are certified in emergency wilderness medicine, carry first aid kits and GPS messengers for wilderness emergencies.

**Environmental Impact:** Due to the large footprint of our luxury basecamps and limited flat and available ground in the wilderness, we ask that guests share tents when possible. Our guides have scouted the best camp locations throughout the wilds of Eastern Oregon for camps that are remote, scenic, and have space for tents that do not harm the land. Leave-no-trace principles are followed on all Go Wild tours.



# TRIP ACTIVITIES

## ACTIVITIES INCLUDED IN EVERY GO WILD ADVENTURE

- **Fly Fishing Instruction / Gear**
  - try your hand at fly fishing for wild native trout in alpine streams and lakes
- **Star Gazing**
  - Set out a blanket at night as our guides walk you through star stories. In Eastern Oregon, see more stars than 90% of the developed world
- **Axe Throwing**
- **Foraging**
  - seasonally dependent- learn about & forage for edible native plants

## OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

- **Sprinter Transportation PDX or BOI to La Grande** (+\$800 each way)
  - *\*subject to availability*
- **Alpine Lake Fishing w/ Float Tubes** (+\$100/person)
  - our mules pack in ultra-lite float tubes and waders for your crew to fish for native brook and lake trout in lakes that rarely see a fly
- **Mountain Masseuse** (+\$250/person) Min 3 people
  - *\*subject to availability*
- **Traditional Archery Shooting** (+\$100/person)
- **En Plein Air** (+\$900)
  - Natural Wilderness Painting Session with local artist
- **Private Backcountry Concert** (+\$900)
  - Evening performance by local singer-songwriter
  - One evening of trip
